HEART DOCTOR, bumped at the start, recovered to gain a position outside foes in the second flight, continued with a steady, three wide bid nearing the turn to challenge the leader in upper stretch, wrested command and drew clear late under pressure. MONGOL MAX, held up in close quarters between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and proved best of the others. GRAND AVENUE broke inwards bumping the eventual winner, was righted to set the pace racing into the turn but failed to sustain his momentum. HEY JAY tracked off the second flight four wide racing into the bend and continued in that path with a steady effort to close the gap in late stages. LICENSE TO STEAL broke outwards bumping SNOWKIN' GUN, was righted to track off the second flight near the inside and made an effort to improve position inside foes late. JOHAR IRISH broke inwards bumping

SNOWKIN' GUN, was going erratically between foes racing as part of the second flight racing into the turn and had no rally. SNOWKIN' GUN, pinched back at the start, settled well out of striking distance and never gained contention. ZULU WARRIOR was a brief factor three deep between foes in the second flight but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. MOTION POTION was urged to contend along the rail, raced in tight through the backstretch and steadily retreated entering the lane. SERRATED EDGE lost contact with the field early and trailed throughout.
