Footnotes

BROWN ALMIGHTY was held up just off the first flight while shifting to the inside racing into the backstretch, tracked the leaders in that position into the second bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out three deep to bid between rivals nearing midstretch and drew clear late under firm right handed encouragement. TELITIKITISCOACH was urged three deep between foes to gain a position off the second flight racing outside a rival in the opening stages, continued with a steady advance just outside the eventual winner to bid three deep nearing upper stretch, struck the front nearing midstretch but couldn't match terms with the winner in the final sixteenth. RULER OF LOVE was urged to gain terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, then stalked just off that foe under light rating racing into the backstretch, forced the issue nearing upper stretch to strike the front entering upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. EXAMEN worked his way to the inside early tracking off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance but finished evenly in late stages. ROI GEORGE, caught four deep approaching the first turn, was eased off the pace while a bit rank under restraint racing outside a rival into the backstretch, shifted outside foes racing into upper stretch but made no real impression. WILD SLEW broke sharply, pulled his way along despite restraint racing into the backstretch, dictated the pace into the second bend and weakened once he was headed in upper stretch. RAKETE settled into stride near the inside early and never gained contention. LITTLE KINKAID, reserved in last racing to the backstretch, never gained contention.
