FIRE TRICKS shifted off the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance under light rating racing into the bend, steadily drew into striking position while shifting out five wide entering upper stretch, then was roused to wrest command in that path in the final furlong, edging clear under pressure. COMPELLING CASE, a bit outpaced in the opening stages, gathered momentum racing through the turn, angled out six wide entering upper stretch but continued with interest to edge a rival for place honors. COURSER stalked just off the first flight along the inside racing into the bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, came through inside foes to challenge in upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. LINDSAYLU gained a position just off the first flight four deep racing to the bend, continued with a steady bid in that path to gain a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch but couldn't sustain her momentum through the final furlong. BABY FACE NELSON settled off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages. HOLY CLASSIC, bumped at the start, was collected to track off the second flight along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out entering upper stretch but offered no rally. LIMEHOUSE DANCER broke inwards bumping HOLY CLASSIC, was righted to chase the pacesetter into the bend, pressed between foes on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. COURTING DELILAH joined the pace three deep soon after the break, dueled for command racing into the turn but gave way early. STEPHANIE'S CAILIN sped to the fore while angling to the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command along the rail on the turn and gave way after a half. KIN KAZAN dropped out early.
