SMILING GAMBLER, unhurried between foes near the inside in the opening stages, made steady progress to gain contention along the inside racing through the turn, came through close quarters while making some light contact with ROYAL ALLUVIAL entering upper stretch, but continued with a steady effort along the rail to wrest command and hold sway to the end under pressure. TSUNAMI SALLI, reserved in last in the opening stages, gradually gathered momentum splitting foes racing into upper stretch, shifted out six wide while finding her best stride late and just prevailed for place honors. LION D N A, held up avoiding close quarters at the, circled into striking distance racing four wide into upper stretch but had no final bid. CAMPO JOTI tracked off the second flight under light rating racing into the bend, briefly continued in hand while racing in some traffic entering upper stretch, then angled to the rail in late stages while continuing evenly. TURTLE PIE angled inwards to force the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, gained a narrow advantage while shifting inwards entering upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid and gave way. EILEEN EVELYN broke slowly, tracked the pace along the inside to the turn, shifted outside foes entering upper stretch and continued evenly. INDIAN ARTIFACT tracked just off the first flight outside foes racing into the turn and steadily retreated entering the stretch. MASQUERADE FASHION was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never menaced. ROYAL ALLUVIAL was urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset while exchanging some contact with PASSIONATELY SWEET on the backstretch, continued dueling for command along the inside into the turn, then was steadied out of tight quarters entering upper stretch and quickly gave way. PASSIONATELY SWEET was a brief factor chasing the pace while exchanging some contact with a rival in the opening quarter and emptied out early.
