**Footnotes**

COZZETTI, within striking distance from the outset, was rated just off the pacesetter inside a rival stalking the leaders racing to the far turn, then came through close quarters in the final stages to narrowly prevail in time under firm left handed encouragement. ALL STORMY showed quickly in front, pulled his way along dictating the pace in hand on a narrow margin racing to the far turn, came under pressure while shifting out, then inwards racing through the stretch, resisted the winner's bid to the end and just missed. SKYRING broke readily to secure terms with the pacesetter from the outset, was firmly rated stalking that foe racing to the second bend, moved to challenge between foes entering upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while just outfinished by the top pair. DADDY NOSE BEST took up a position just off the first flight outside a rival while under light rating in the opening half, shifted out three deep on the far turn while moving to striking position, continued under pressure in that path racing through the stretch and was just outkicked. QUICK WIT, off a step slowly, was reserved in the last flight along the inside racing to the second bend, swung out six wide in upper stretch and made some belated progress. THE PIZZA MAN was settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to race five deep between foes in upper stretch but made no real impression. SOUTHERN PARKWAY tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the far turn, shifted out four deep nearing upper stretch and steadily faded. MACHO BULL was reserved off the second flight saving ground throughout but came up empty nearing upper stretch.
