HIGHEST GRADE raced close up inside, rallied in the stretch and drew off late. CHURCH CART raced five wide near the middle of the field and rallied for the place while not a threat. INDIAN MOONSHINE lacked speed off the rail and rallied belatedly for a share. ACT LIKE A LION lacked speed and improved his position. FROSTEDWITHCLASS made a three wide bid but faltered. DISTORTED GROOM raced close up off the rail and gave way. NAVAJO NATION was never a factor. HONEY GLAZD TURKEY raced close up between horses and gave way. BARAKIEL'S SWORD trailed throughout.
