CELLULOID HERO broke sharply, dictated the pace along the inside under light rating, shook clear in upper stretch and held safe the challenge of MOOJAB under steady pressure. The latter came through tight quarters at the start to gain a tracking position just off the first flight, angled three wide after a half commencing a steady challenge but couldn't gain terms with the winner. BILL OF BILLS tracked just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, made a brief bid leaving the bend and flattened out nearing midstretch. CITY NUMBER, reserved outside foes in the last flight early, made some progress while caught four wide racing through the turn to upper stretch and had no final response. WILL'S HONEY broke a step slowly, then was bumped soundly at the start by GALLOPING GULCH and never gained contention. GALLOPING GULCH swerved outwards bumping WILL'S HONEY at the start, was righted to track the leaders along the inside but steadily faded along the rail nearing upper stretch.
