Footnotes

FOLLIA secured a forward placing outside foes from the outset, attended a rival's pace under light rating racing into the bend, pressed for command entering upper stretch, edged away to a clear advantage in late stages and held safe the challenge of SHANE'S SPIRIT under firm left handed encouragement. The latter moved to a tracking position in second flight between foes racing to the bend, shifted outside the leaders entering upper stretch, steadily closed the gap on the winner to the end but was always second best. WILLIE PREVAIL was hustled to the lead soon after the start, disputed the pace inside a rival racing into the bend, couldn't match that foe leaving the furlong marker and gave way. THE NEXT SAINT was urged to contend in the opening sixteenth along the rail, lost some position nearing the bend while being taken in hand, switched outside foes on the turn to race five wide into upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. COURTESY TITLE, unhurried between foes in the opening stages, was held up out of close quarters leaving the half mile marker, switched out nearing the bend to race four wide into upper stretch but had no further response. ABOUNDING APTITUDE broke inwards bumping KING BEE, was settled just off the inside racing to the bend and never gained striking distance. DEACON PAPA PETE tracked the leaders three wide in second flight, drifted out racing through the turn and gave way. KING BEE, bumped at the start, was righted to gain a tracking position in second flight along the rail and dropped out early.
