**Footnotes**

HUXLEY WINNER was guided to the inside in early stages while securing a position in the second flight, tracked the leaders unhurried to the second bend, shifted out splitting foes on the far turn moving to striking distance, continued with a steady bid to challenge the pacesetter in upper stretch and prevailed in time under firm right handed encouragement. HAPPY CHOICE broke outwards, was settled off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued inside foes on the second bend gathering momentum, shifted out with a sharp move to challenge four deep in upper stretch and continued to make steady progress to the end while only second best. COSSET, pulling against a rating hold while securing the lead from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin outside a rival into the backstretch, moved clear midway through the far turn, held sway on a clear margin past midstretch but failed to sustain her momentum through the final sixteenth. EYES OF A SAINT, shuffled back out of close quarters at the start, tracked off the second flight under some reserve racing to the far turn, swung five wide entering upper stretch and was making solid progress late. TWILIGHT MEMORY, on terms with a rival on the lead from the outset, attended that rival's pace under some reserve racing along the rail to the backstretch, couldn't match that foe after six furlongs and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SILKEN MIST, reserved well off the field for six furlongs, never gained contention. FORTHELONGHAUL tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight to the far turn, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch and quickly gave way. ALL HER DUE, pulling a bit in early stages, tracked just off the first flight racing three deep to the far turn and emptied out abruptly after six furlongs.
