ALLURING SQUALL hopped a bit at the start, raced under some reserve three deep tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into striking position while shifting out four wide on the second bend, moved to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch and surged clear racing through the lane under firm encouragement. DELUXE HEIR, reserved well off the second flight outside a rival to the backstretch, steadily moved to contention following the winner's path on the far turn, moved to challenge that rival in upper stretch while shifting inwards under pressure, couldn't gain terms with that foe but proved best of the others. LAWFUL LADY settled outside a rival in the opening five furlongs, made steady progress four deep nearing the midway point of the far turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch while being roused to challenge, couldn't match the top pair and narrowly held a rival for third. JANICE JONES settled into stride while angling to the rail, raced unhurried to the second bend, gathered momentum while switching off the inside midway through the far turn, swung six wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to improve her position. LONDON MIST angled to the inside early tracking off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn, split foes four wide in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. FLEET CLASSIC, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue between foes racing through the far turn but came up empty nearing midstretch. RAVE REVIEWS tracked unhurried off the second flight just off the inside in the opening stages, then split foes near the inside racing into the stretch while making no impression on the leaders. PENELOPE PERFECT, held up off the second flight in the opening half, continued between foes into the second bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. FEELS GOOD tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second

flight in the opening half, advanced to make a brief, three wide entering the far turn but emptied out quickly in upper stretch. PRINCESS JEWEL tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. HOLY POW WOW, urged to the fore along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the far turn, dueled inside foes entering the far turn and gave way abruptly after six furlongs.
