BREATH TAKING BREEZE raced in the second flight with a rail trip and was roused at the top of the stretch while getting to the winner too late. WINDS DUE EAST settled early and rated while three wide but made no rally. MAXY LEVENS flashed brief foot while inside then gave way in the stretch.
