LETSGETITONMON set the pace and led into the lane, was getting out and was bumped late by PETECAROL then held sway. PETECAROL rated in the second flight, made a four wide bid on the turn then raced greenly in the lane and bumped LETSGETITONMON late. HAZARDS OF LOVE raced close up and had a rail trip, dropped back then came again late inside. TIZ A THEME raced in the middle of the pack, ducked in and impeded RED OAK RIDGE then closed willingly. CAPTAIN STONE showed no speed, was asked while seven wide and made a mild rally. SUPRAMAN hit the gate and had a rail trip, angled out and showed some run late. CHEROKEE MATE raced in the second flight and flashed brief foot then faded in the lane. STAND AND APPLAUD rated in the middle of the pack, made a five wide bid on the turn but made no rally. RED OAK RIDGE was rushed up and pressed the pace, steadied at the top of the stretch then faded.
