BUILT TO PRECISION broke sharply and opened up, was roused in the stretch then drew clear. LOGAN'S PRIZE settled along the inside, had a rail trip and steadied on the turn then ran on late. WILLIE TO TO raced close up here then took back early and came again late. BAD BANDIT broke sharply then took back, angled out and closed willingly. SOUND BARRIER was squeezed back at the start then angled out and moved up early, made a bid but faltered. FAMILY FACTS settled on the inside, was asked along the rail but made no rally. HEYHEARMEROAR showed no speed, was asked on the turn but made no rally. FIELDSTONE rated in the second flight between horses, flashed brief foot then tired.
