Footnotes

A SHOT AWAY gained a position just off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out nearing upper stretch splitting rivals while moving to striking distance, was carried out a bit near midstretch while being brushed by SAM'S PHILLY but continued with a steady bid to wrest command and draw clear late under firm encouragement. SAM'S PHILLY was urged to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into upper stretch, shifted out nearing midstretch while being roused to turn back the winner brushing that foe but proved no match in late stages. MYSTERY RIDGE angled to the inside early while gaining a position inside foes in the second flight, moved to challenge along the rail entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. PREMIUM CUT, off a bit slowly, settled along the inside well off the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position to late stages. KNOTTS was settled off the second flight between foes in the opening quarter, gathered momentum midway through the bend, swung five wide in upper stretch while moving into contention but finished evenly in the last furlong. SURFER ROSA broke slowly, settled into stride, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position along the rail to the end. ALLIE

KITTEN went up from the break to prompt the pace outside a rival, pressed the issue into the turn and gave way after a half. OH GEE SHE'S GOLD settled outside foes in early stages, was caught four wide racing through the turn and offered no rally. CAP'N SWIFTER, urged to contention three deep in the opening quarter, chased the leaders in that path through the bend and steadily faded after a half. PAYKAY, urged along four deep in the second flight racing through the backstretch, retreated from contention early. BRAZEN TASH was never a factor.
