PERFECT CASTING was settled in hand outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, gradually gathered momentum on the far turn, swung out five wide entering upper stretch while moving to challenge, took over while drifting inwards nearing the sixteenth marker and drew away in a ridden out effort. COPPER FOREST gained a position leading the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening five furlongs, made a steady advance to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. BERLIOZ, held up three deep in the second flight in the opening half, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch to bid between foes, couldn't match the top pair but continued with a mild response to edge a rival for a share. CANTONIC sped to the fore along the inside from the break, dueled for command inside a rival into the far turn, edged clear in upper stretch but faltered in the last furlong. TURNPIKE TOMMY, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes near the inside racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing while making no impression. CARTOUCHE settled outside foes in the opening stages, shifted out leaving the far turn and came around some tiring rivals. BOOM BOOM CHARLIE, reserved between foes racing to the backstretch, never gained contention. GRAY went up to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, dueled for command while gaining a narrow edge racing into the far turn but gave way abruptly nearing midstretch. COURTESY TITLE shifted a bit off the inside in the opening stages, angled inwards on the backstretch to track the leaders along the rail in the second flight but steadily from contention on the far turn.
