Footnotes

HAVELOCK exchanged some contact with YANKEE INJUNUITY in the opening stages then shifted out to gain a position off the second flight racing three deep to the bend, steadily advanced to striking distance racing four wide midway through the turn, angled inwards to challenge for command three deep entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to just edge COUNTRY DAY in time under firm encouragement. The latter broke sharply, relinquished the lead to stalk the pacesetter along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn while moving to challenge for command, gained a narrow advantage nearing midstretch, resisted the winner to the end but lost the advantage in the final strides when taking a few awkward steps. WEKIVA WACHEE tracked the leaders behind the second flight along the rail under some reserve in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch while gaining position inside foes, then shifted out in the final sixteenth to split foes and gain a share. BIRDIE BEATS PAR broke inwards bumping THREEFORALL, was hustled to the lead while angling sharply to the inside, set the pace into the bend, dueled for command inside a rival into upper stretch, resisted that foe past the furlong marker but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. YANKEE INJUNUITY exchanged some contact with the eventual winner soon after the start, shifted out of traffic settling off the second flight in the opening stages, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch advancing in tandem with HOMEBOYKRIS and continued to make mild progress in that path to the end. HOMEBOYKRIS, off last, shifted off the inside gaining a position between foes off the second flight, switched out of close quarters to race five wide into upper stretch and continued to make some mild progress between foes. CHIEF OF AFFAIRS, in striking position between foes in the second flight soon after the break, was eased back from that position avoiding close quarters approaching the turn, shifted to the inside on the bend while being urged to challenge but steadily faded in the drive. CAPITOL APPEAL bobbled a bit just after the start while a bit slow to gather stride and never gained contention. THREEFORALL exchanged bumps with BIRDIE BEATS PAR at the start, was righted to briefly chase the pacesetter three deep into the bend but emptied out nearing upper stretch.
