LIFTING THE VEIL raced near the middle of the field, steadied entering the stretch, split horses, rallied to the lead and drew off under a mild hand ride. CHANCEY LIGHT saved ground, angled out for the drive and rallied for the place while no threat to the winner. AWESOME FRANCES raced close up just outside and took a short lead on the final turn but could not last. ABSOLUTE JO lacked speed and improved her position. BAYANI gained steadily to the stretch but faltered late. RUBY GLITTER set the pace inside and tired. COMBAT SOLDIER raced close up three wide and tired. MY PATRIOT LADY was always outrun. (Race run in lane 1, rail at 0.).
