MANEKE, forwardly placed between foes from the outset, led the second flight just off the inside while making steady progress to gain terms with the pacesetter nearing upper stretch, drew on terms with that foe leaving the furlong marker and narrowly prevailed under firm handling. ATTICUS KRISTY broke readily, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the bend, then grudgingly resisted the winner to the end. TRYING BRIAN tracked just off the second flight under some reserve early, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to earn a share. HANDS ON, off a step behind his foes, moved to a tracking position in second flight along the inside while under some reserve, moved to challenge entering upper stretch and was just outfinished for a share. ASHTONOFUN, unprepared for the start, lost position to the field after the start, switched outside foes to race six wide into upper stretch but made little impression on the leaders. MCMURPHY was settled near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to race five wide in upper stretch but had no rally. HAPMAN, prominent three wide early, chased the pacesetter outside foes into the turn and gave way in upper stretch. WAXING soon trailed.
