Footnotes

HANCHO, held up just outside the leaders in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep after six furlongs, took charge under pressure entering upper stretch and was taken in hand in the final stages once the issue was decided. RULEROUS tracked just off the leaders between foes in second flight racing to the bend, shifted out in upper stretch, couldn't maintain terms with the winner but proved second best. EASY tracked the pace under some reserve behind the second flight between foes in the opening half, angled out entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position. SHOW YOUR FACE tracked the pace unhurried along the inside in the opening half, switched outside foes on the bend to advance four wide leaving the turn and continued evenly to late stages. GOLDPOINT, forwardly along the placed inside in the opening stages, pressed for command along the rail racing into the bend, dueled into upper stretch and gave way. PERSONALITY KID tracked just off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, then steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. IRON CHAMP broke inwards, worked his way to the inside in the opening stages but never mounted a serious challenge. SKIP THE HATCHET, caught in tight quarters at the start, was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. KOKOMO GYPSY broke slowly, saved ground throughout but never seriously menaced. BORN SUPREME was urged to the fore while angling nearer the inside, dueled outside a rival into the turn and emptied out after six furlongs. COLONEL KLINK stumbled at the start, recovered quickly to briefly contend outside foes as

part of the second flight but stopped abruptly after a half.
