NUCKSER sped clear of his foes along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace under firm rating through the backstretch while opening a commanding margin and held sway to the end under firm hand urging and a few right handed taps. HOPE FOR TODAY tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued under reserve into the second bend, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and made some late progress to narrowly prevail for place honors. AFLEET PADDY settled in hand outside foes racing to the backstretch while well off the second flight, swung five wide entering upper stretch and made some belated progress to edge a rival for a share. DOUG JUNIOR tracked the leaders near the inside as part of the second flight while being rated just out of striking distance in the opening half, improved his position inside foes entering the far turn, couldn't close the gap on the winner and lost some position in late stages when his rider appeared to misjudge the finish line. DEVILS TOWER, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter along the inside racing into the first turn, shifted out midway through the backstretch while losing some position to the leader, continued between foes in the second flight racing through the far turn and steadily faded in the drive. PRINCE OF SPEED settled near the inside in early stages and never seriously menaced. RIVER OF NO RETURN, off a step slowly, never gained striking distance.
