Footnotes

RULER OF THE COURT, bumped at the start, was held up along the inside racing as part of the second flight in the opening half, made a steady advance to striking distance on the far turn, briefly awaited an opening leaving the second bend, then came through inside foes racing through the stretch to prevail in time under steady handling. HYPE, exchanged bumps with MR. SEABRA at the start, was reserved out of tight quarters along the rail racing into the first turn, shifted out on the backstretch, commenced a steady advance in tandem with a rival three deep entering the far turn, continued in that path to upper stretch while striking the front, shifted out under left handed urging nearing the furlong marker bumping PIANO MAGIC and narrowly edged that foe for place

honors while failing to contain the winner. PIANO MAGIC, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, advanced in tandem with HYPE racing four deep entering the far turn, was bumped by that foe nearing the furlong marker and was just outfinished for second. SWORD AND SHIELD, bumped at the start by TAP N POINT, was reserved well off the field in the opening half, shifted out nearing the far turn to circle foes five wide gaining striking distance entering upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. HEZA BOXER, prominent between foes racing to the first turn, was eased off the first flight to track the leaders between rivals racing into the backstretch, then continued with an even effort between foes racing into the stretch. GAGE PARK was settled off the second flight in the opening half, split foes three wide racing through the far turn and made an effort to improve position. NINTH CLIENT settled well off the field racing to the backstretch, continued four and five wide racing through the far turn while gaining some position but made no impression on the leaders. SOUTHERN MUDD, held up off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, came up empty racing through the far turn. MR. SEABRA exchanged contact with HYPE and RULER OF THE COURT at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to the fore along the inside, dictate the pace on a clear margin into the second bend but emptied out nearing upper stretch. TOQUINHO, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter from the break, chased the leader into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. TAP N POINT broke outwards bumping SWORD AND SHIELD, was righted to gain a position three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, but steadily faded racing through the far turn. RULEROUS, urged to secure a forward placing four deep racing into the first turn, continued to track the pacesetter three deep on the backstretch and gave way abruptly entering the far turn.
