TELLME ALL ABOUTIT broke readily to gain a position outside a rival on the pace, forced the issue racing through the bend, moved clear entering upper stretch and continued gamely to the end to hold safe the challenge of LINE IT UP under firm right handed encouragement. The latter secured a position just off the first flight within striking distance in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid to challenge three deep entering upper stretch, steadily closed the gap to the end but failed to gain even terms with the winner. WABASH MOON broke sharply, was rated tracking off the second flight racing to the bend, steadily moved to contention while angling out four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while earning a share. ELUSIVE CHAMPAGNE, reserved out of tight quarters soon after the break, split foes on the turn advancing into upper stretch and continued to make steady progress to the end. BAYOU TORTUGA, shuffled a bit when racing in some traffic early, commenced a steady advance four wide racing through the turn and continued to improve her position in that path to late stages. EDIE settled into stride near the inside while in last, shifted out nearing upper stretch and came around some tiring foes. HULCOTE ROSE (IRE), forwardly placed near the inside tracking the leaders in second flight racing to the bend, steadily faded nearing upper stretch. PRAIRIE PRIZE tracked the leaders between foes off the second flight early, angled to the rail entering the turn and steadily retreated from

contention. ROYAL POSH was hustled to dispute the pace inside a rival racing to the turn, forced the issue through the bend and gave way in upper stretch. SNICKER BELLE tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages but dropped out of contention early. ELISSA GREELEY settled off the second flight in early stages but quickly dropped out of contention.
