HARLAN ASH raced near the middle of the field, angled out and lacked a rally. BLACK TIGER lacked speed and showed little. MOST OF ALL was never a factor. STONE SMOKESTER set the pace from between rivals and tired. MISS TSUNAMI was always outrun.
