OCALA MIST took over the lead just after going a quarter mile, set the balance of the pace with a clear lead on the rail and held sway while drifting out in the stretch. MALTESE INDY raced close up three wide, rallied late and was getting to the winner at the wire. MAJESTY'S LASS lacked speed and belatedly rallied up the rail for a share. CURIOUS CONUNDRUM stalked the pace from off the rail and weakened. PATTI PEACH stumbled at the start and saved ground to loom a threat in the stretch but faltered. MANICURED lacked speed and showed little. RUPERT'S FIRE raced four wide near the middle of the field and weakened. RENAISSANCE FAIR was always outrun. AUTOGRAPHED COPY had the most early speed and tired.
