RICHIESGIRLGOTGAME set a pressured pace, dueled in the lane and was all out to best TIZ MIZ SUE. TIZ MIZ SUE was never far back, dueled in the lane and was outnodded at the wire. TOOL TIME GIRL was unhurried early, made a middle move six wide but was no match for the top two. CHASING THE QUEEN had a rail trip and a mild rally. ABLE raced mid pack and lacked a late response. SUPERIOR ATTITUDE loomed a threat then dropped back. COUNT THE CHANGE broke inward, bumped at the start and raced widest in the stretch. MARDI GRAS INDY broke slowly then passed tiring rivals. STORMIN BON was bumped at the start and had no rally inside. STAR STRIKE was shuffled back at the start and outrun. NO EXAGGERATION stalked the pace off the rail, was used up and stopped in the stretch.
