Footnotes

GREY KNIGHT broke readily, dictated the pace under rating into the bend along the inside, responded when urged to go clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. BETTER MAKE MONEY angled inwards to track the pace between foes in second flight, shifted out in upper stretch and prevailed for the place. HAMMER JAMMER stalked just off the pacesetter racing to the bend, couldn't match terms with that foe after a half and weakened. GUT KING worked his way to the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted off the rail late to improve position between foes. DOUBLE JUMP was switched out early gaining terms with the second flight, raced four wide into upper stretch and had no final response. NOLAN'S TERRITORY was settled off the leaders, switched outside foes racing into the lane but made no impact.
