Footnotes

GYPSY BABY (IRE) saved ground under reserve to the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn while moving to terms with the second flight, stumbled when clipping heels leaving the quarter mile marker, switched out in upper stretch to split foes four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a steady late response to prevail under strong handling. WINPINS, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to press the pacesetter racing into upper stretch, resisted several rivals to late stages and gamely prevailed for the place. BELLE BREEZE angled in to gain position outside a rival in second flight, moved to terms with the leaders three deep on the far turn while under some reserve, moved to gain a narrow advantage nearing midstretch but was outfinished by the top pair. LUCKY GAL tracked the leaders unhurried off the inside to the far turn, came through close quarters splitting foes three wide leaving the second bend and continued willingly between foes to the end. SHEZA SWEET LEMON tracked just off the second flight along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out after a half to bid between foes while in close quarters nearing upper stretch but weakened in late stages. HOT KITTEN was guided to the rail in the opening stages to track the pace from out of striking distance, moved to contention saving ground on the second bend, then raced in tight quarters through the final quarter while continuing with interest. MISS SIPPY was settled along the inside in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. MEMORY HARBOR never seriously menaced. JO'S FINALE tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, was caught wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded. DEAR FRIEND was urged to gain command racing outside a rival to the backstretch, set the pace into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
