Footnotes

LEWIS' ANNA, carried out at the start, was collected to track the leaders outside rivals in the second flight from just out of striking distance racing to the far turn, moved to challenge four deep nearing upper stretch, wrested command approaching the furlong marker and held sway to the end under strong handling. CONTEMPORARY ART, reserved in last off the rail in the opening stages, continued outside a rival to the second bend, swung five wide racing into upper stretch while being prompted to advance, moved to striking distance nearing midstretch but couldn't gain even terms with the winner. A NICE SLEWISH BOY tracked off the first flight along the inside in the opening half, was urged to gain position between foes racing into the stretch and prevailed for a share. ROPE DANCER settled in the last flight along the inside racing into the far turn, shifted out avoiding some traffic racing into upper stretch and continued three deep late in an effort to improve position. COSMIC BREW ducked outwards at the start impeding the eventual winner, was urged to the lead three deep racing into the first turn to dictate the pace on a narrow margin into the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes on the far turn into upper stretch and gave way. DOVER BEACH, in touch with the first flight between rivals early, shifted out on the far turn to lodge a brief, three wide bid but came up empty racing into upper stretch. PROPER AMERICAN, urged to gain a forward placing along the inside maintaining contact with the pacesetter in the opening half, pressed the issue along the rail racing into the far turn and gave way.
