POSSIBLE DREAMS broke readily to gain a narrow advantage outside foes while being prompted to force the pace, maintained a narrow advantage while angling to the rail racing into the turn, then held a challenge from ELUSIVE KNOLL racing through the stretch to prevail under firm right handed encouragement. The latter bobbed at the break, was quickly righted to gain a position along the inside racing just out of striking distance, made steady progress inside foes to gain terms with the pacesetter entering upper stretch, altered course avoiding close quarters approaching the furlong marker while continuing with interest but proved only second best. COACHES CHOICE, caught four wide in early stages tracking just off the leaders, continued with a steady, three wide bid racing into the turn but lacked the needed final response. MAMA MARTINI, in touch with the pacesetter between foes early, shifted out prompting that foe racing into the turn to upper stretch but gave way nearing midstretch. ARGUE THE TOSS settled into stride in last near the inside early, switched out racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. NOMOREWAR settled near the inside in the opening stages and never gained contention. SHES A BULLSEYE tracked off the second flight three deep in the opening stages and came up empty racing into the turn. TRUE NIGHTMARE was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening quarter but retreated early.
