Footnotes

CHE SERAI, held up between foes in the second flight stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, pulled her way clear entering the turn, was roused in upper stretch to maintain her advantage and held EAGER EM safe to the end under firm handling. The latter, reserved just off the second flight in the opening half, split foes three deep midway through the bend while being roused to advance, angled to the rail in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to challenge inside the pacesetter late while proving only second best. BOBBIE N HER GIRLS settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the turn, was held up avoiding traffic leaving the turn, swung five wide in upper stretch but continued willingly to the end to close the gap while earning a share. FEATHERINTHEBREEZE tracked the pace between foes in the second flight under light rating early, shifted out to briefly challenge the pacesetter nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. MONA MONA, slow to gather stride, came through inside foes to make brief progress nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. PLEASANTLYBDANCING tracked the pace three deep between foes in second flight in the opening half, was jostled a bit when caught in close quarters entering the bend and steadily faded. ORPHANELLIE tracked the pacesetter four wide in second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SHEGONNAWIN, prompted to secure the lead along the inside early, pulled her way along dictating the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn but emptied out early.
