CABERNEIGH was firmly rated off the second flight racing a bit off the inside to the second bend, continued under patient handling racing through the far turn shifted out four deep entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge and narrowly prevailed in time under firm left handed encouragement. CROSS VILLAGE, held up just off the leaders racing three deep in the second flight in the opening half, steadily advanced on the leaders to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch, moved to gain the advantage between calls in late stages but couldn't quite fend off the winner. ULTIMATE X., reserved in last while guided to a position just off the inside racing to the backstretch, swung five wide leaving the midway point of the far turn while looming into contention and continued willingly in that path to late stages to close the gap while prevailing for a share. MY SONNY BOY settled in hand along the inside tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out entering upper stretch to challenge three deep between foes and continued with a mild bid. SLEW CITY STORM, reluctant to load, moved to the fore along the rail from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside to upper stretch and emptied out in the last furlong. DAVID D, reserved just off the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the second bend, was urged to challenge nearest the rail entering upper stretch but had no final kick. GAELIC STORM led the second flight between foes in the opening half, moved to prompt the pacesetter racing into the far turn but quickly came up empty in upper stretch.
