Footnotes

MULATA took up a position outside a rival in the second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, commenced a steady advance nearing upper stretch while shifting out three deep and found her best stride in late stages to narrowly prevail in time under firm right handed encouragement. KENTUCKY GAL secured the lead along the inside just after the break while under light rating early, attended the pace inside a rival racing to the turn, lost some position to the leader while continuing under patient handling on the bend, shifted outside that foe to bid between rivals leaving the midstretch in tandem with the winner and was just outkicked. ROYAL POSH, off a step behind the leaders, split foes to join a rival on the pace in the opening quarter, moved to gain the advantage midway through the backstretch, dictated terms a bit off the inside while widening the advantage racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum. FRIENDLY SELECTION, off last, settled off the second flight in the opening half, angled four wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. LIL CARMELITA was a brief factor tracking the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
