MARKET BUZZ broke readily, was reserved just out of striking distance along the rail tracking the leaders as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted outside the pacesetter to bid between foes racing through the far turn and continued with a steady bid to wrest command leaving midstretch, drawing away late under pressure. EXPLOSIVE DART settled between off the second flight racing to the backstretch, advanced to striking position along the inside racing through the far turn, shifted outside the leaders in upper stretch and prevailed for place honors while never threatening the winner. LOVE THY NEIGHBOR was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, briefly resisted the winner's bid nearing upper stretch but gave way in late stages when proving no match. BREWMISTRESS ducked out at the start momentarily impeding SHESADENOUNCER, was righted to take up a position outside the eventual winner racing as part of the second flight, moved in tandem with that foe to lodge a brief, three wide bid entering the second bend but lacked the needed final response. SHESADENOUNCER, shuffled back out of close quarters at the start, settled into stride well off the second flight and never gained contention. SPIRIT OF A NATION, caught four wide racing as part of the last flight to the backstretch, never gained contention. ROSIE'S WILD TALE was prompted to join the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, continued just off the leader to the second bend and gave way entering the far turn. SILVER SUNRISE tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch but dropped out early.
