CAM AND CON'S GIRL joined the pace outside a rival from the outset forcing the issue, edged forward to a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch, then gamely held several challengers to late stages under strong handling while shifting out late. SHEZADOOZIE tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, made a steady bid on the leader to challenge that foe racing past midstretch, continued in an extended skirmish between foes while being carried out a bit by the winner late and was just outfinished. BELLA ANN, reserved in last early, swung out on the turn commencing her advance, raced four wide into upper stretch, drew on terms with the top pair late but lacked the needed final kick. BEAUTIFUL HUMOR tracked off the second flight early, made a steady gain three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, then altered course avoiding some traffic late. KISSES REQUIRED tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing into the bend and came up empty racing into upper stretch. FLAGRANT FOUL broke slowly, raced a bit erratically along the inside nearing the turn and offered no rally. GREELEY'S WORLD, urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset, gave way racing into upper stretch. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE RIDER OF SHEZADOOZIE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
