Footnotes

VINO LIMBO TANGO broke outwards crossing into the path of RARE COURAGE, was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace on a narrow margin into the backstretch, turned back several foes racing into upper stretch and maintained the advantage to the end under firm handling. RARE COURAGE, caught in tight quarters at the start, was reserved off the second flight along the inside to the far turn, came around a tiring foe racing into upper stretch, then switched inside the leader to challenge that foe along the rail in late stages. HOME GROWN HERO tracked off the second flight outside foes, then made a

steady, four wide advance to close the gap on the top pair in late stages. PETEIZUM, forwardly placed prompting the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes on the far turn but weakened in late stages. PRAIRIE RIDGE came through close quarters after the start to gain a position off the second flight, shifted outside foes while moving to challenge three deep racing through the far turn but flattened out leaving midstretch. SCOT'S SUNNYRIVER tracked off the first flight three deep racing into the far turn and steadily faded nearing the lane. SOMEWHERE IN TIME, caught four wide racing to the first turn, never gained contention. SHERIFF BART tracked off the first flight while caught four wide racing into the far turn but retreated early. CAPTAIN AMERICAN was never a factor. SIR BLUEGRASS, reserved along the inside in the opening half, never gained contention. SGT. MAJOR ROSS exchanged bumps after the start, recovered to track three deep between foes but dropped out early. WICENTY, bumped after the start and shuffled back early, never menaced.
