PUT IT ON saved ground while not far back, angled out in the stretch and rallied to the lead late. RACING A PLENTY set the pace from the inside on a long lead then could not last over the winner. GO GO HASTY lacked speed, angled out for the drive and gained belatedly. DELECTABLE made a bid in the stretch but flattened out. STARMINDED lacked speed then gained belatedly. DOWAGER LADY raced close up inside and weakened. PRESIDENTIAL POWER was void of speed and improved her position late. BUGSY MAE raced close up off the rail and tired. PEGGY'S POST raced just outside near the middle of the field and tired. REID IT N THE NEWS stalked the pace from just outside then was vanned off after pulling up. I BE SHY was always outrun.
