**Footnotes**

CORRESPONDENT reserved just out of striking distance in the opening stages, was pulling a bit while steadily moving to contention between foes racing into the far turn, came through tight quarters while exchanging contact with several rivals racing into upper stretch but was roused to gain the advantage leaving the furlong marker. OUT IN FRONT, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out avoiding traffic racing into upper stretch, angled five wide nearing the furlong marker and continued with interest to prevail for place honors. STREET LINE, bumped at the start worked her way to the inside in the opening half, shifted out midway through the far turn to bid three deep between foes while racing in tight quarters in upper stretch but had no final kick. ROARINGOODMARTINI, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, was caught four wide on the far turn while briefly gaining striking distance but had no final kick. JULIE DARLIN, steadied avoiding traffic along the inside early, continued in last to the second bend, was fanned six wide entering the stretch but made no impact. RUNNING ROYALTY, forwardly placed in the opening stages stalking the pacesetter, lodged a brief bid three deep entering the far turn but emptied out while racing in close quarters nearing midstretch. BELLA VIDA joined the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch, pressed the pace between foes into the far turn and gave way leaving the furlong marker. PICK AND CHOOSE settled outside foes in the opening stages, made brief progress four wide after a half but retreated early. FRANK'S HOPE sped to the fore along the inside, set the pace into the far turn the far turn and was steadied out of close quarters while giving way nearing upper stretch.
