SHEZASMITTENKITTEN was urged to secure the lead while angling over racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin into the second bend, was roused to turn back a challenger racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. MISSMOLLYBYGOLLY, reserved well off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily gained position inside foes on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and found her best stride late to prevail for place honors. DUNDALK DANCER tracked the leaders three deep in second flight racing to the backstretch, made a steady advance to contention while angling to the rail racing into the far turn, shifted off the inside while being roused to challenge entering the lane but had no final kick. LIL HEAT settled between foes well off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing into the lane while being urged to advance and made some mild progress late. WAVE OF THE WAND, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, shifted outside foes racing into the far turn, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but continued willingly to late stages. I O CASHEL, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter while

shifting off the rail racing into the backstretch, lodged a brief bid racing through the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. VIRGINIA'S JOY tracked off the second flight outside foes while caught four wide early, made a brief, three wide bid racing into the far turn but lacked the needed final response. BLUE JEAN BABY, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, never gained contention. DEFIANT SUSIE, in contention between foes, was eased back off the second flight while angling to the rail racing into the backstretch and steadily faded entering the far turn. OUR CHOCOLATE CHIP was never a factor. RUNAWAY ABACO showed little. ROAMING BROOK was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but steadily retreated racing into the far turn.
