Footnotes

WESTERN CHARM was rated out of striking distance early while angling nearer to the inside racing into the bend, made steady progress nearing upper stretch to split foes just off the inside entering upper stretch and edged forward in time under strong handling. SHARP A tracked off the second flight outside rivals in the opening stages, commenced a steady, four wide advance on the turn to challenge just outside the winner racing into upper stretch but was just outkicked. AMBITIOUS DANCER tracked the leader inside a rival in second flight while shifting a bit off the inside early, moved to challenge for command racing nearest the rail leaving the turn but failed to sustain her momentum. MISS DARLA, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out racing into the lane and made mild progress between foes late. MILLIES STAR tracked the pacesetter outside a rival as part of the second flight early, moved to challenge three deep between foes on the turn but came up empty entering the lane. CAPPADORA was never a factor. SUNDAY CHOIR was urged to the lead a bit off the rail in the opening stages, contested the issue between foes on the turn and emptied out after a half.
