Footnotes

MY OPTION, reserved between foes tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing into the first turn, shifted out four deep nearing the second bend while continuing under patient handling, steadily advanced on the leaders in that path racing through the far turn while not being asked for her best, was roused to challenge outside foes racing into upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure but continued with a solid late kick to fend off FRIVOLOUS under firm handling. The latter bobbled at the break, was quickly righted to track off the first flight inside foes racing into the first turn, steadily drew into contention after a half while shifting a bit off the inside, came through close quarters to bid three wide between foes nearing upper stretch, then altered course racing through the lane to bid outside the eventual winner, continuing with interest to the end to close the gap. SKY GIRL was urged to terms with the pacesetter prompting that foe racing into the backstretch, moved to press the issue after a half, continued with a steady bid to edge forward between calls racing into upper stretch but yielded to the top pair late. BOLD KITTEN settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, angled to the rail after a half while being prompted to gain some position, saved ground tracking just off the leaders through the far turn, switched outside foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. GOLD EDGE was urged to secure the lead along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin early, dueled for command inside a rival racing into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. SEANEEN GIRL shifted off the inside early while being prompted to maintain striking distance stalking the first flight, was urged to lodge a brief bid three deep between foes racing into the far turn but dropped out nearing upper stretch.
