GUIDED TOUR was allowed to settle into stride while stalking the pace of DUCKHORN, went up outside of that one to challenge on the second turn, took clear command in the stretch and drew off while kept to his task. A FLEETS DANCER was void of early speed inside, began moving closer inside turning for home, came out to go around DUCKHORN in the stretch and rallied for the place while no danger to the winner. DUCKHORN broke sharply, quickly cleared and dropped to the rail, set all of the pace from the inside but could not go with the winner and weakened in the late going. CHICAGO SIX raced near the middle of the field while off the rail but had no response when asked for run and also weakened. MILWAUKEE BREW raced three wide while trailing throughout.
