Footnotes

LAKE POSSE, urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset, gained a narrow advantage after the opening quarter, shook clear midway through

the bend and held sway to the end under steady encouragement. I'D MARRY ME broke inwards bumping BYANECKONTRAIL, was quickly righted to stalk just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the bend, made some progress to challenge inside that foe entering upper stretch but was always second best. GREYHAWK angled inwards to track the leaders between foes off the second flight, split foes advancing to contention on the turn, shifted out three wide in upper stretch, then continued with a steady bid to close the gap while edging a rival for a share. IDEAL ALLUVIAL tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail off the second flight racing to the turn, made steady progress inside foes on the turn, then shifted out racing through the stretch while continuing willingly but just missing for a share. MARITIME MAN, reserved in hand, was guided nearer the inside after the opening furlong, made some progress to split foes on the turn, then improved his position four wide between foes in late stages. MACHIAVELLI broke slowly, was held up well off the inside racing to the turn, was fanned six wide entering the stretch and gained some position while making no impression. FAMILY SIX, unhurried along the inside racing well out of contention early, continued evenly into the stretch. SPREAD THE CHIPS tracked the leaders racing four wide behind the second flight into the turn, continued wide to the stretch and had no impact. BYANECKONTRAIL, off slowly, then bumped at the start, never gained contention. SOUTHLAND JAZZ broke sharply, chased the pacesetter four deep racing to the turn and gave way after a half. ONE MORE TAP was steadied in traffic not long after the start and never menaced thereafter. HEY NEIGHBOR flashed brief pace three deep between foes but emptied out after three furlongs.
