**Footnotes**

DONTBETELLINME was reserved behind the second flight racing along the rail in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance entering the bend, shifted out advancing through the close quarters racing through the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to edge GRETA'S RAP in time under firm left handed prompting. The latter sped to the fore along the inside soon after the start, opened a commanding margin midway through the turn but failed to sustain her momentum through the final furlong. LITTLE FRANCES was urged along pursuing the leaders near the inside as part of the second flight, saved ground on the bend and continued willingly along the rail into the stretch while closing the gap and prevailing for a share. GUTIEREZ GIRL tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight racing to the turn and continued evenly between foes in late stages. TACTICAL KATIE, prominent leading the second flight into the turn, tracked the pacesetter from just out of striking distance for a half but couldn't produce the needed closing response. BONITA BETS tracked the pace four wide off the second flight racing to the turn and steadily faded after a half. ANYONESHOME, a bit outpaced in early stages, came around some tiring rivals racing into the stretch. PARTY DANCE, restless in the gate prior to the start, hopped at the break losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter. PASSPOST TO PARIS, a bit slow into stride, never mounted a serious challenge. SHARP TRIP tracked off the second flight racing five wide in the opening quarter and dropped out of contention early.
