Footnotes

TOP SURPRIZE, reserved in hand while shifting a bit off the inside early, continued unhurried between foes into the backstretch, made steady progress to close the gap on the first flight in tandem with several foes on the far turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued with a steady response to wrest command and edge clear in time under some moderate urging in a ridden out performance. MR. MISCHIEF angled inwards while gaining terms with a rival on the lead in the opening stages, attended that foe's pace to the second bend, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but held a rival for second. HARVEST HOME angled to the inside in the opening stages to track off the first flight from just out of striking distance for five furlongs, made steady progress to gain terms with those foes while angling three deep leaving the far turn, couldn't match the winner's kick but continued evenly between foes to prevail for a share. PHOTO SHOOT, held up along the inside racing to the backstretch, split foes making some progress near the inside on the far turn to upper stretch, then shifted out four wide in late stages while missing for a share. CHARGING HOME assumed command near the inside while being rated in the opening stages, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn, disputed the lead inside foes into upper stretch but weakened in late stages. GOLD FORMER was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. FLATTERMEJIM angled to the inside tracking the leaders from out of striking distance for a half but steadily faded nearing the far turn. ALBIN tracked the leaders outside a rival racing to the far turn, then steadily retreated on the second bend.
