Footnotes

AT THE FINISH, held up between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, split foes three wide entering upper stretch to challenge and drove clear. A SHOT AWAY joined the pace three deep in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes while shifting inwards racing into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but held a rival for place honors. BREZING RAIN, reserved near the inside tracking just off the second flight racing into the turn, briefly awaited an opening while advancing in close quarters between foes nearing upper stretch but continued willingly to the end to just miss for second. SHE'S AN ALPHA GAM tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and finished evenly. SPRINGTIME SPELL disputed the pace between foes from the outset, shifted to the inside on the turn dueling for command and gave way leaving midstretch. SHES GOT TO RUN shifted out early tracking off the second flight, continued four wide on the turn to upper stretch and lacked a closing bid. ROSSINI'S MUSE briefly disputed the pace inside foes in the opening stages but retreated along the rail early. WHYPRINCESSWHY shifted outside foes early to lodge a brief, four wide bid entering the turn but emptied out early.
