UPSELL broke outwards brushing MOONBIE, was quickly righted, then urged to dispute the pace while nearest the rail racing into the turn, gained the advantage on the bend, shook clear racing into upper stretch and just maintained the lead to the end under steady right handed pressure. WEKIVA WACHEE, off last, settled into stride along the rail racing into the turn, steadily gathered momentum while shifting off the inside entering upper stretch, switched to the four path and produced a solid late response to just miss. TWELVE HUNDRED broke sharply, prompted the pace three deep racing into the turn, lost some position to the winner nearing upper stretch but continued willingly between foes to the end while just missing for place honors. YANKEE INJUNUITY, shuffled back avoiding close quarters in the opening stages, continued between foes under light reserve racing into the turn, then split foes three deep racing through the stretch while making some mild progress late. J. PA tracked just off the first flight four deep in the opening stages, lost some position racing through the turn, was fanned five wide entering upper stretch and continued evenly. ROARIN MISSILE vied for command under pressure between foes racing into the turn, couldn't match the leaders and gave way entering upper stretch. MOONBIE, brushed at the start, tracked the leaders out of striking position near the inside racing to the turn, shifted out approaching upper stretch and quickly came up empty in the drive.
