**Footnotes**

MANDOLA, reserved out of striking distance while shifting nearer to the inside in the opening stages, shifted to the rail on the backstretch while commencing a steady advance to contention, drew into striking distance along the rail on the second bend, shifted out three deep to challenge the leaders nearing midstretch, then wrested command and went clear under pressure while setting a new track record. REACH FOR THE SKY, urged to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace into the second bend, resisted a rival's challenge racing into upper stretch, couldn't fend off the winner but edged forward late to prove best of the others. LARGE SCALE tracked just off the first flight outside a rival in the opening stages, split foes racing into the far turn while being urged to challenge the leader, pressed the issue to midstretch but flattened out late. RECURRENT, reserved along the inside racing into the backstretch, continued just off the rail saving some ground on the far turn and continued with an even effort while improving his position. NO TIME TO KID (IRE) settled last while angling to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and continued with an effort to gain some position while making no real impression. IN RED'S HONOR tracked just off the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. BALLISTIC TIM raced three deep tracking the leaders from out of striking distance racing to the far turn but never gained contention. POPEYES A SAILING broke a bit awkwardly, was urged to gain a contending position racing just off the pacesetter in the opening half but was spent early.
