FAN CLUB'S MISTER broke sharply from his inside post, took over the pacesetting on the first turn, set the pace with pressure to his outside, repulsed a challenge from MONSIEUR CAT turning for home and drew off under urging. MONSIEUR CAT briefly took a short early lead, continued prominently to press the pace from the outside, challenged turning for home then could not match strides with the winner in the drive and settled for the place. ROYAL SPY raced close up off the rail and made a mild bid between calls on the final turn but lacked a further response. SLIGO BAY (IRE) lacked speed inside but could off no response when asked for his best. HEPTAGONE raced just outside near the middle of the field but tired in the drive. RAHY'S SECRET broke outward to get away last and trailed throughout. CHEROKEE KIM was pulled up on the first turn and was vanned off.
