NAGYS PIGGY BANK, brushed at the start, recovered to gain a position in second flight along the rail tracking the leaders unhurried racing to the bend, commenced a steady advance while shifting off the inside midway through the bend, moved to wrest command nearing the furlong marker and drew away in late stages under brisk handling. FOUR LEFT FEET, off a bit slowly, settled into stride a bit off the inside, shifted to the rail entering the turn advancing to contention, angled out in upper stretch, made steady progress to the end to prove second best but couldn't gain terms with the winner. POWERFUL ZEN broke inwards bumping IN ALL DIRECTIONS, was righted to quickly gain command, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside racing into the bend, briefly resisted the winner's challenge but gave way leaving the furlong marker. DOMAIN'S RAP was rated between foes in the second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. IN ALL DIRECTIONS, bumped at the start, was held up off the second flight while shifting to the inside, then made an effort to pass inside some tiring foes racing into the stretch. HART OF A COWBOY tracked the leaders four, then three deep racing through the backstretch to the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. CAJUN DIABLO broke inwards brushing the eventual winner, was collected, then urged to secure terms with a rival near the pace, couldn't match that foe after a half and emptied out leaving the bend.
