SEALAUNCH was settled into stride near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes entering the far turn, swung four wide leaving the midway point of the second bend commencing her advance, then continued in that path into upper stretch to wrest command in time under steady handling. BERRY KNOLL broke a bit awkwardly, settled along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out on the backstretch to track the leaders between foes racing into the far turn, awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, angled out five wide in late stages and made some late progress to secure place honors while closing the gap. KUHLU moved to terms with several rivals on the pace while between foes early, continued to dispute the issue inside a rival into the far turn, resisted several foes past the sixteenth marker but yielded late. HALLIE RUTH, forwardly placed along the inside tracking just off the first flight racing to the far turn, couldn't produce the needed final bid. POBRECITA joined the pace three deep racing into the first turn, pressed the issue outside a rival racing into the far turn to upper stretch but emptied out in late stages. CLASSY GHOST tracked just off the first flight three deep to the far turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. SPEEDY BULLET settled between foes in the opening stages but dropped out after a half.
